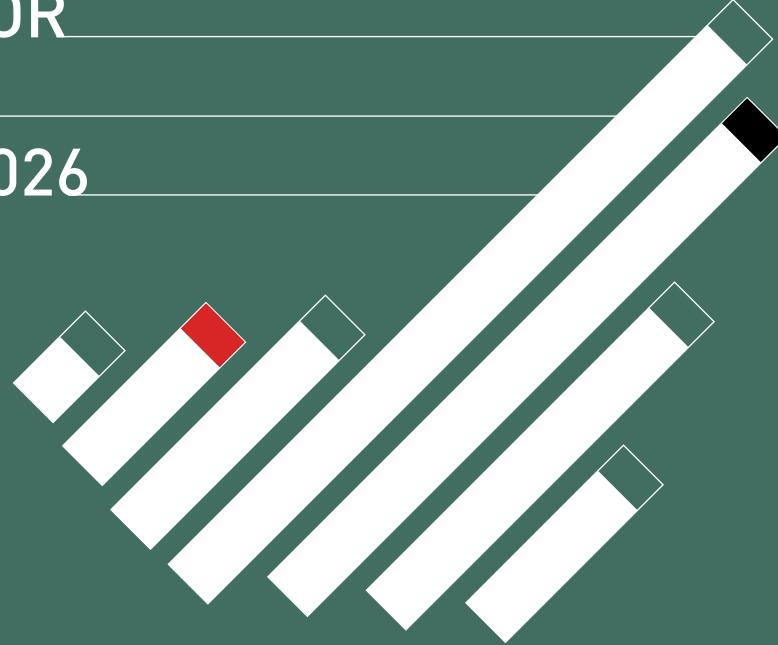

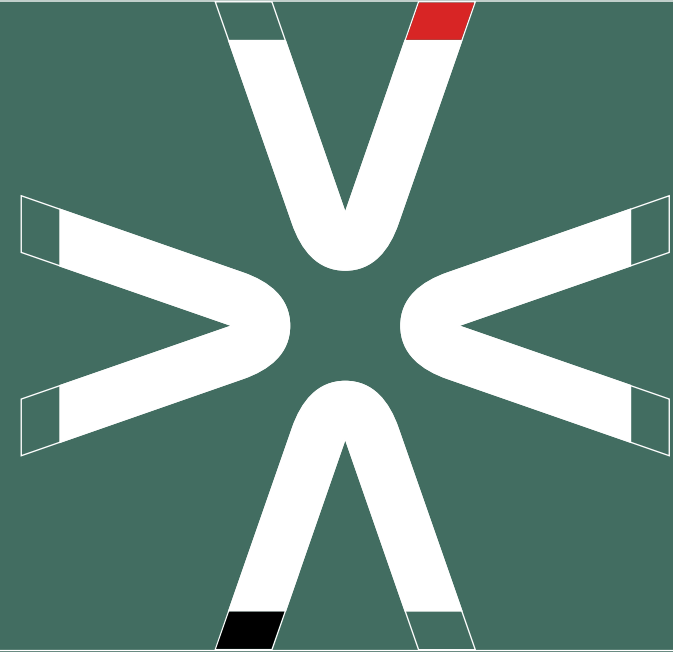


TDRA'S JOURNEY WITH THE ITU

2003

- Participated in the Regional Radiocommunication Conference

2006



- Submitted a report on Digital Broadcasting, chaired a Working Group level, 225 succeeded in obtaining digitally coordinated channels
- Participated in WTDC, Qatar
- Elected as ITU Council Member

2007



- Hosted its first major ITU event, the Global Symposium for Regulators
- His Highness Sheikh Mohammad Bin Rashid AL Maktoum, Vice-President and Prime Minister of the UAE, Ruler of Dubai met the ITU Secretary General
- Developed input document for Arab agenda and submitted to the WRC, chaired a Working Group
